REGULAR MEETING MAYOR AND COUNCIL OCTOBER 24, 2016

Opening Items

Mayor Chegwidden called the Meeting to Order.

Mayor Chegwidden read the Open Public Meeting Statement.

Roll Call

Mayor Chegwidden requested Roll Call:

Flag Salute

Mayor Chegwidden led those in attendance with the salute to the American Flag.

Open to the Public

In accordance with Local Ordinance O-18-03, "Persons making public comment at the first public portion shall be limited to five (5) minutes. During the second public portion, the Mayor or Council President shall have the discretion to terminate any repetitive, irrelevant or excessive public comment in the interest of permitting all members of the public time to speak on any governmental issue and completing the public business within a reasonable period of time".

Mayor Chegwidden opened the meeting to the public.

<u>Bill Skewes:</u> Mr. Skewes had some questions about the agreement with the redeveloper that is coming later on the agenda and parking with the redevelopment. Mayor Chegwidden advised that we do not currently have the foot traffic to sustain businesses, so making parking available helps to promote new businesses. Mr. Skewes then asked about the salt content in the water. Mr. Rheinhardt advised that it occasionally exceeds the level which needs to be reported but not the level where action needs to be taken.

No one else wishing to be heard, Mayor Chegwidden closed the meeting to the public.
