

NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Wharton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, on February 8, 2010. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building at 10 Robert Street, in said Borough on March 8, 2010 at 7:30 o'clock P.M. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office in said Municipal Building, in said Borough for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title:	Bond ordinance appropriating \$590,000, and authorizing the issuance of \$360,000 bonds or notes of the Borough, for various improvements or purposes authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Wharton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey
Purpose(s):	Acquisition by purchase of new and additional vehicular equipment, including, but not limited to, one (1) garbage truck for use by the Department of Public Works of the Borough. Improvement of various streets and locations in and by the Borough, including, but not limited to, Elizabeth Street, Walnut Street and Ford Avenue.
Appropriation:	\$590,000
Bonds/Notes Authorized:	\$360,000
Grants (if any) Appropriated:	\$130,000
Section 20 Costs:	\$75,000
Useful Life:	8.05 years
