

BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Borough of Wharton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, on February 23, 2009 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office in the Municipal Building in said Borough for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title:	Bond ordinance providing for the renovation of a municipally-owned building for use by the First Aid Squad of the Borough of Wharton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, appropriating \$300,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$70,000 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation
Purpose(s):	Renovation of a municipally-owned building for use by the First Aid Squad of the Borough and located at 23 Ross Street in the Borough including all structures, equipment, work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto
Appropriation:	\$300,000
Bonds/Notes Authorized:	\$70,000
Grants (if any) Appropriated:	\$80,000
Section 20 Costs:	\$30,000
Useful Life:	15 years
