A few accomplishments from this year include the Police Department moving back into their renovated headquarters. Chief Fernandez and Lieutenant Young continue to do a great job managing the force. This year, with the support of outgoing Chief Cronin and the Mayor and Council, we were able to approve the purchase of a new fire truck. #### Mayor Chegwidden's Remarks:

Some accomplishments from 2015 include water main replacements on Second Street, Church Street, and Kitchell Avenue. Most of these projects were funded with grant money including \$80,000 for Second Street and \$80,000 Church Street. There is a \$160,000 grant that is coming in this year for West Central Avenue. We worked with the Morris County Parks Commission to complete some of the walking loop at the Canal. The County Road is finally moving forward. We acquired the property for the new water tank and received funding for the construction of the tank from our negotiations with Pondview. The estimated cost of that project is three million dollars. This will help to solve the water pressure issues on the north side of town. Looking ahead, we are planning on road improvements in Sterling Heights, East Central Avenue, and some others. We have teamed up with the Park Commission and a train group to revitalize the old railroad tracks with trolley cars. All of which will be paid for by the train group. Main Street improvements will continue. Morris County will pave the road this year and we will be putting in new crosswalks. Some developments that have happened include the opening of Avalon Bay. The traffic fears that were expressed prior to the development have not materialized and the impact on the school is very minimal. A new apartment complex that is going in where the green tent blighted property is has been approved. We are talking with Chase Bank to acquire that property to create a central parking lot for our businesses and residents in the center of town. Financially we are very sound, the books have been closed for 2015. We remain the second lowest municipal tax per capita in Morris County. We are the fourth lowest in per capita tax in total taxes. He'd like to wish everyone a happy New Year and to thank all of the employees and all of the volunteers of Wharton who make this little town what it is. He would also like to thank the Council for working as a team year in and year out, it really is a pleasure. One last thing he'd like to point out is that this year our debt is paid off. You'll see that some of the projects that will be done this year and are able to be done because we no longer have debt payments to make and can use the money to repair the things that we need to.
