NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Wharton, County of Morris, New Jersey as follows:

The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director or the Division of Local Government Services to include as a Dedication by Rider in the 2015 and subsequent budgets, revenues received for Outside Employment of Off-Duty Municipal Police Officers within the Borough, be spent in accordance with the rules and regulations
- 2. The Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this Resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
