

RESOLUTION RESTRICTING WATER USAGE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton is facing a high water demand and a severe drought is forecasted; and

WHEREAS, to assure a continued supply, it is appropriate to impose water restrictions before the supply is in danger.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Wharton, in accordance with local ordinances, that they hereby impose water restrictions as follows:

Effective August 15, 2016 thru October 31, 2016, Even-numbered municipal addresses are permitted to use outdoor water on EVEN-NUMBERED DAYS and odd-numbered municipal addresses are permitted to use outdoor water on ODD-NUMBERED DAYS. Those municipal addresses with odd and even numbers will follow the odd number rules.

Outdoor water usage pertains to watering of all lawns and gardens, washing of vehicles and filling of swimming pools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any person or business that is found guilty of violating the water use restrictions shall be fined a minimum of \$100 to a maximum of \$500 or imprisonment for ten days or both. The enforcement of this water restriction will be the Wharton Police Department.
