Said Agreement is on file in the office of the Borough Clerk and may be inspected by the public during normal business hours.
- 2. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Interlocal Services Agreement on behalf of the Borough.
- 3. A copy of the fully executed agreement shall be forwarded to the Morris County Joint Insurance Fund.
