- Section 2. The Clerk of the Borough is hereby directed to prepare and file a copy of this resolution with the Local Finance Board as part of such application.
- Section 3. The Local Finance Board is hereby respectfully requested to consider such application and to record its findings, recommendations and/or approvals as provided by the applicable New Jersey Statute.
