WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton wishes to apply for funding of approximately \$30,000 with a match of \$150,897 for an approximate project total cost of \$180,897 for a project under the Safe and Secure Communities 20-1439 Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Subaward period for this funding is February 9, 2020 through February 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has reviewed the accompanying application and has approved said request and is authorizing the acceptance of said Subaward; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Borough of Wharton, for the purpose described in the application.
