

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wharton, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, pursuant to the authority vested in it by an act of legislature, has heretofore by ordinance provided for the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Borough of Wharton; and

WHEREAS, the following named Liquor License holders have filed an application for license renewal and the Borough Clerk has received a Tax Clearance Certificate for these establishments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following liquor licenses, known as Plenary Retail Consumption Licenses be granted renewal for the period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021:

***License is granted with the following conditions:**

- 1. The establishment will have an employee present outside during the hours of operation to monitor activities**
- 2. Outdoor operations end at 10:00 p.m.**
- 3. All amplified music or entertainment outdoors must end at 10:00 p.m.**

****License is granted with the following conditions:**

- 1. All outside operations will end at 10 p.m.**
- 2. All patrons will be moved indoors at 10 p.m.**
- 3. There will be no games, competitions or the like permitted outside**
- 4. There will be an employee present outside at all times when patrons are present**
- 5. There is to be no entertainment or amplified music permitted outside.**

***** License is granted with the following conditions:**

- 1. During the hours when entertainment is provided, bands, disc jockeys and the like, A.I. and Dutch, LLC is required to provide adequate security for crowd control. One security person for the first fifty (50) patrons and an additional**

security person for every additional twenty-five (25) patrons until the maximum occupancy of the establishment has been reached.

2. Cameras shall be installed to monitor all public areas. The equipment shall record activity in the establishment on a twenty-four (24) hour loop. Tapes shall be maintained for a period of thirty-days and made available to police for review upon request
3. A security guard must be stationed outside during closing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk issue the Licenses herein granted, the same effective as provided by law.
