RESOLUTION RESTRICTING WATER USAGE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton is facing a high-water demand and a drought watch has been issued by the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, to assure a continued supply, it is appropriate to impose water restrictions before the supply is in danger.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Wharton, in accordance with local ordinances, that they hereby impose water restrictions as follows:

Effective August 15, 2022 thru October 31, 2022, Even-numbered municipal addresses are permitted to use outdoor water on EVEN-NUMBERED DAYS and odd-numbered municipal addresses are permitted to use outdoor water on ODD-NUMBERED DAYS. Those municipal addresses with odd and even numbers will follow the odd number rules.

Outdoor water usage pertains to watering of all lawns and gardens, washing of vehicles and filling of swimming pools.
