

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SIMULTANEOUS EXECUTION OF NJDOT
UTILITY ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT (UECA-09-
GUIDERAIL UPGRADE NORTH, CONTRACT 2026-233760) AND UTILITY
ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT MUNICIPAL AMENDMENT
(UPC-233760)**

**WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is
undertaking a public improvement project known as the Guiderail Upgrade North,
Contract 2026-233760; and**

**WHEREAS, this project requires certain engineering, construction, or relocation
adjustments to municipal utility infrastructure; and**

**WHEREAS, the NJDOT has submitted a Utility Engineering and Construction
Agreement, designated as UECA-09-Guiderail Upgrade North, Contract 2026-233760, to
define the scope and responsibilities of this work; and**

**WHEREAS, a Utility Engineering and Construction Agreement Municipal
Amendment, designated as UPC-233760, has been prepared to supplement and amend the
master agreement; and**

**WHEREAS, NJDOT requires the simultaneous execution of both the master agreement
(UECA) and the municipal amendment.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of
Wharton, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:**

- 1. Authorization to Execute. The Mayor and the Municipal Clerk are hereby
authorized and directed to execute the Utility Engineering and Construction
Agreement (UECA-09-Guiderail Upgrade North, Contract 2026-233760) and the
Utility Engineering and Construction Agreement Municipal Amendment (UPC-
233760).**
- 2. Simultaneous Execution. The authorization granted by this Resolution is strictly
conditioned upon the concurrent, simultaneous execution of both Agreements.**
- 3. Certified Copies. The Municipal Clerk is authorized and directed to forward three
(3) certified copies of this Resolution to the New Jersey Department of
Transportation.**
- 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.**
